DESCRIPTION: Tubac Golf Resort & Spa is an intimate, full-service destination resort on the historic 1789 Otero Ranch. Set on 500 acres surrounded by the Santa Rita and Tumacácori Mountain ranges, the resort features golf, tennis, dining, a spa and year-round swimming and relaxation amid historic structures and lush natural vegetation and gardens.

The resort opened in 1959. A multi-million dollar renovation completed in 2008 included the addition of a Guest Services Center, Pro Shop and Clubhouse, a replica 17-century mission style chapel, a full service spa and salon, a retail village featuring a décor and design gallery, a 2,700-sq. ft. conference and banquet facility and 50 additional haciendas (for a total of 98 rooms), and expanded indoor and outdoor dining and lounge areas. The golf course was recently renovated to improve play and harmonize with its natural surroundings

LOCATION: 35 miles south of Tucson International Airport and 20 miles north of Nogales, Mexico; adjacent to the historic Village of Tubac in Santa Cruz County, Arizona.

DIRECTIONS:



From Tucson International Airport, turn left (north) onto Valencia Blvd. Continue three miles to Interstate 19 south. Drive 33 miles to Exit 40 (Chavez Siding Road) and follow the signs to Tubac. Turn left at the Arch.

LODGING: 98 rooms and suites including: 52 Haciendas each with a state-of-the-art sound system, flat screen TV, jet tub, walk-in shower, sunken living room area, fireplace and patio; 20 Casitas each with separate living room and bedroom, fireplace and private patio, some with kitchenettes; 27 Posadas--spacious rooms with separate dressing area; Otero Suite in the historic Otero Hacienda—bedroom, living room, den with kitchenette, fireplace and private patio with golf course and mountain views.

The resort reserves designated pet-friendly rooms. Rates are seasonal and range from \$159-\$349 per night, double occupancy. Additional charges apply for extra persons and pets.

DINING: Stables Ranch Grille is open for breakfast, lunch and dinner and offers southwest cuisine and a nice wine list. The restaurant features rock floors and hand-hewn beams and is one of the historic centers of the property as it was the location of the original stables for the Otero Ranch. The bar, adjoining the restaurant, is the ultimate tack room, with hand-crafted mesquite wood bar and wine rack, regional artifacts and restored saddles that serve as barstools. Life music is featured every Friday and Saturday night.

Apache Room & Patio spectacular mountain views and a front row seat to the signature par 3, 9th hole. Open daily for breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Room Service available from 7 a.m. until 10 p.m. daily.

GOLF: The 27-hole, championship course designed by Red Lawrence and the new nine, 8 of which were designed by Tucson golf course architect Ken Kavanaugh offers three nine's with five tee boxes to meet every golfers' ability. Course rating and slopes range from 72.5/133 to 66.1/115. The fairways are Bermuda grass (over seeded with winter rye in fall; greens are bent grass. The mature course was refurbished in 2003 and now features a par-3, 140-yard finishing hole with an island green. The original front nine remains the same. It's named the Otero Nine, a reference to the Otero Family that first resided there. The Rancho Nine starts with the old 12th hole, a short par-4 that calls for a tee shot across the Santa Cruz River. The Anza Nine winds up with the original 10th through 12th holes followed by the relatively new short par-3 with the island green. Another featured hole is the no. 4 Rancho, par-5, which was featured in the 1996 movie "Tin Cup". A new golf shop, locker room and practice area were added in 2004.

The course renovation recaptured the relaxed, countryside ambiance of the Otero Ranch. The course spans both sides of the Santa Cruz River offering diverse elevations, challenges and spectacular views. Split rail fencing meanders throughout defining cart paths and fairways while cattle graze lazily along the river's banks.

Seasonal rates including cart are \$60 to \$110. Proper attire is required; soft spikes only. Open to the public. Tee times at 520.398.2021.

SPA & SALON: Treat yourself to an array of services and state-of-the art amenities, all thoughtfully designed with a Southwest flair and with your needs in mind. Each step deeper into this sensory retreat is a step closer to restoration, replenishment and complete rejuvenation. Enjoy our sauna or steam room or co-ed Jacuzzi with the warm desert backdrop.

MEETINGS AND EVENTS: 2,700-sq. ft. Conference Center with dividable meeting and banquet space, pre-function space and covered and open patios encircling the center. 720-sq. ft. and 406-sq. ft. conference rooms in the historic Otero House with 4,000 sq. ft. of outdoor function space for meetings and events. 3,200-sq. ft. chapel with mounted screen and high-speed internet for meetings, banquets, weddings. The resort offers full-service catering, audio-visual equipment, entertainment options, and shipping and receiving and executive business services.
